Annex A – REVISED MAY 2023

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PROGRAMME - REVISED

As of the coming into force of the present by-law, the City of Côte Saint-Luc ("City") will provide a rebate towards the purchase of water filters to every single-family home and duplex built prior to 1976, which are located in the areas in which the city believes there are water service lines made of lead. To apply for the rebate, applicants must complete the online application found on the City's website or fill out the form provided in Annex B of the present by-law. The rebate can only be applied to purchases from October 1, 2019, onward. The filter must be certified NSF/ANSI 53 or NSF/ANSI 58 for the removal of lead.

The rebates are as follows:

1) **An annual rebate up to \$50** for residents that purchase above the sink NSF-53 filter(s) to reduce lead in drinking water (see below);

Above the sink filter can be any of the following:

- <u>Pour-through pitcher/carafe</u>: Water drips through a filter in a water pitcher using gravity.
- <u>Faucet mount:</u> Mounts on kitchen faucet. Uses diverter to direct water through a filter.
- <u>Counter-top connected to sink faucet:</u> Connects to existing sink faucet through a hose/tubing.
- Refrigerator filter: Installed in your refrigerator and typically dispensed through the refrigerator door.
- Rental cost for a leased under-sink reverse Osmosis system installed in the property owner's home.
- 2) A one-time rebate up to \$200 for residents that purchase an under-sink system certified NSF-053 or NSF-58 that connects to your plumbing under the sink.

In lieu of the rebates available in options (1) or (2) mentioned above, the City may provide, by request, a **one-time filtered water pitcher** (certified NSF-53) to qualifying property owners.
