BY-LAW NO. 1913

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BY-LAW CONCERNING MAINTENANCE  
IN THE WINTER OF STREETS,  
SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES  
IN THE CITY OF CÔTE SAINT-LUC  
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At a Regular Monthly Meeting of the Municipal Council of the City of Côte Saint-Luc, held at the City Hall, 5801 Cavendish Boulevard, on Monday, December 15, 1986, at which were present:

WHEREAS the City is empowered under section 415, sub-paragraphs 10 and 23, of the Cities and Towns Act (RSQ, c. C-19), to provide for winter maintenance of streets, sidewalks and public places in the municipality.

THAT IT BE ENACTED AND ORDAINED by By-Law No. 1913 of City Council, and it is hereby enacted and ordained, subject to all the approvals required by law, as follows:

ARTICLE 1. The Public Works Department shall be responsible for the winter maintenance of streets, sidewalks and public places in the municipality.

ARTICLE 2. The clearance of snow from streets, sidewalks and public places shall be carried out by vehicles of the Public Works Department or such other vehicles as may be under contract to the City.

ARTICLE 3. The snow may also be blown or piled on private grounds fronting the street or sidewalk in a manner to prevent damage to persons and property.

ARTICLE 4. Only snow removed in trucks belonging to the City or authorized under special contract to it shall be deposited at the municipal snow dump or such other dump as may become necessary.

ARTICLE 5. Any unauthorized person who deposits snow from a truck at the site of the municipal snow dump shall be guilty of an offense under this By-Law.

ARTICLE 6. It shall constitute a nuisance for any person other than the Public Works Department, or a person under contract to it, to pile snow on a street, sidewalk or public place.

ARTICLE 7. The Director of Public Works, or his assistant, is authorized to temporarily divert traffic from certain streets in cases he deems it necessary for snow removal operations.

ARTICLE 8. The Director of Public Works, or his assistant, is authorized to order the installation of no parking signs on any street preliminary to the commencement of snow removal operations and the said signs shall be removed as soon as the snow removal is completed.

ARTICLE 9. Any vehicle parked in a street in violation of a no parking sign installed by the Public Works Department shall be guilty of an offense under this By-Law.


ARTICLE 10. The Director of Public Works, or his assistant, is authorized, if he deems it necessary, to order the removal of any parked vehicle which hinders snow removal operations on any street in the City.


ARTICLE 11. Any parked vehicle ordered removed because it hinders snow removal operations may be towed to a garage at the expense of the owner, who thereafter may recover possession thereof only upon paying the actual towing and storage costs.

ARTICLE 12. The cost of snow removal operations shall form part of the general expenses in the annual budget of the City.

ARTICLE 13. Any person contravening Article 5, 6, 7 or 9 of the present By-Law shall subject the offender, upon conviction in Municipal Court, to a minimum fine of \$50.00, with or without costs, and in default of payment to a term of imprisonment to be determined at the discretion of the Municipal Judge. The maximum fine that may be imposed by the Municipal Judge shall be \$500.00 and the imprisonment shall not be for more than two calendar months. Any term of imprisonment, however, shall cease at any time before the term fixed by the court upon payment of the fine and costs imposed.

ARTICLE 14. This By-Law shall come into force according to law.
