WHEREAS the Council may make by-laws to secure the  
peace, order, good government and the general welfare of its  
population;

WHEREAS it is expedient to ensure the protection of the  
residents against possible assaults;

WHEREAS it is expedient to control the carrying of  
cutting and thrusting weapons which are frequently used as means of  
assault;

THAT IT BE ENACTED AND ORDAINED by By-Law No. 2005  
entitled, "BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE CARRYING OR THE USE OF CUTTING AND  
THRUSTING WEAPONS IN PUBLIC PLACES", as follows:

ARTICLE 1. In this by-law, 'public place' means any  
place where the public is explicitly or implicitly invited.

ARTICLE 2. It is prohibited for any person to be in a  
public place, street, park, on foot or in a public transportation  
vehicle and having or carrying a knife, a sword, a machete or other  
similar weapons, without valid reason.

For the purpose of this article, self-defence does not  
constitute a valid reason.

ARTICLE 3. Whoever contravenes any of the provisions  
of this by-law, shall be liable for each offence, of a fine not  
exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) with or without costs, or  
in default of payment of the said fine or the said fine and costs,  
to an imprisonment not exceeding sixty (60) days. The amount of the  
fine and costs and the term of imprisonment shall be set by the  
Court of competent jurisdiction. However, the imprisonment shall  
cease upon payment of the fine, or of the fine and costs, as the  
case may be. If the infraction continues, such continuation  
constitutes a separate offence, day by day.

ARTICLE 4. The present By-Law shall come into force  
according to law.
