BY-LAW NO. 44.-

Minutes of the meeting of the Council
of the Municipality of the Village of Côte St. Luc,
held on Tuesday the 3rd of July 1934, at eight o'clock
P.M., at the meetings hall, 674 Westminster Avenue,
at which meeting were present:-

Mr. the Mayor Pierre Lemieux occupied the chair.

Proposed by Mr. Fred D. Lamont
Seconded by Mr. Donald Fletcher
And resolved that by-law no. 44, as read
at this meeting by the secretary, be and is by these
presents adopted.

BY-LAW NO. 44.-

Whereas notice of motion concerning the
adoption of the present by-law has been duly given:

Whereas that in the interest of good order
of the Municipality it is advisable that the following
by-law be adopted.

It is enacted as follows:-

10. It is forbidden to park, loiter, wander
or to meet with others on or upon indeterminate lots,
not constructed lots, vacant lots, fields or lands within
the Municipality, without being able to keep a good
account of himself or themselves, a good account of their
making noise by screaming, swearing, or singing or by
having a tumultuous or disorderly, or by disturbing the
peace in any way, or by being drunk, within the limits
of the Municipality.

20. Every person infringing any section of
this By-law shall be liable to a fine not exceeding
Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) and costs, for every infraction,
and in default of immediate payment of such fine with
costs, every such person shall be liable to imprisonment

for not more than one month (1), but such imprisonment shall cease on payment of said fine and costs. If the infraction continues, such continuation shall constitute a separate offence, day by day, during its continuation.

The present by-law replaced the by-law no. 41 of this Municipality which therefore becomes null and without effect.

The present by-law will come into force fifteen days after its publication.
