### WINNERS CEREMONY PRESENTATION - MAISONS FLEURIES CONTEST

Councillors Mike Cohen and Sidney Benizri presented the winners of the *Maisons Fleuries* contest by Electoral District. Commemorative photos were also taken.

# **QUESTION PERIOD**

The question period started at 8:30 p.m. and finished at 8:50 p.m. Five (5) people asked to speak and they were heard.

### 1) Rhoda Albert

The resident opined that the newly built building on Marc Chagall is causing a disaster on Marc Chagall as there are materials strewn all over the street such as construction cones and garbage piled up in boxes which projects all over the street; the latter occurring for the duration of the last week. Mayor Brownstein then explained that he, along with staff, personally meet with the representatives of the developer every two weeks as part of a sub-committee with representatives from each multi-family building on Marc Chagall. He then suggested to the resident to speak to her Condominium Administrator for future complaints but for these particular complaints raised tonight (which he is only now hearing for the first time), he would take note of the comments.

#### 2) Toby Shulman

The resident expressed concern regarding the North/South traffic on Cavendish Boulevard. The resident then inquired as to whether any additional streets in Côte Saint-Luc can be open to through-traffic. Mayor Brownstein explained that there is an indirect route (Cavendish Extension) which is targeted to open up.

# 3) Irving Itman

The resident referred to item **5a)** on tonight's Council agenda related to the Order of Council to Sell Immovables and inquired as to why it was on tonight's Council Agenda to which Mayor Brownstein responded that this is an annual resolution adopted by the Côte Saint-Luc City Council however, in the past years, all immovable owners who were in tax arrears had their arrears paid thus no immovable was in fact sold.

The resident then inquired as to how many people applied for temporary car shelter permits to which Director Senekal responded 55. The resident then stated that those temporary car shelters that are up are *beautiful*. The resident then stated that the \$75 annual (permit) fee to have a temporary car shelter was excessive.

### 4) Dr. Bernard Tonchin

The resident (on behalf of his fellow residents) wished to thank Council for authorizing temporary car shelters in certain zones and then opined that the City should authorize temporary car shelters City-wide. Mayor Brownstein then explained the rationale as to why the by-law could not apply City-wide.

### 5) Jeff Joseph

The resident inquired as to what the Agglomeration *quote-part* increase is projected to be for Côte Saint-Luc for 2019 to which Mayor Brownstein and Councillor Erdelyi both responded approximately .56%. The resident then inquired as to whether the Kirwan Park Baseball fields will be operational while the future park renovations were taking place to which Councillor Kujavsky responded that they would not.

The resident then inquired as to whether there would be further public consultations related to Kirwan Park to which City Manager Abramovitch responded in the affirmative.

The Comité de transition de l'agglomération de Montréal ("The Transition Committee") reached this Agreement on May 27, 2005 for and in the name of the Island of Montreal municipalities to be reconstituted and the Union des municipalités du Québec ("UMQ") for a three-year period: January 1, 2006 to December 31, 2008;

WHEREAS the "UMQ" was mandated by the Transition Committee to act as the representative of this association known as the *Regroupement des municipalités de l'Île de Montréal* (RMIM) and, as such, the UMQ assumed the responsibilities of advisor and deductible fund manager;

WHEREAS a call for tenders was made by the City's original consultants, Optimum Gestion de risques ("Optimum"), Division de Optimum Actuaires & Conseiller Inc. and by the "UMQ" for the "RMIM";

WHEREAS on December 14, 2005, the Côte Saint-Luc City Council, ("Council"), via resolution number 051217, approved the Agreement reached on May 27, 2005 by the Transition Committee for and in the name of the municipalities to be reconstituted on the Island of Montreal and the "UMQ" for the three-year term beginning on January 1, 2006 and ending on December 31, 2008 for the purpose of purchasing group property insurance with a possibility of a group deductible;

WHEREAS at its Regular Meeting of July 14, 2008 Council adopted a new agreement along with the reconstituted municipalities who were party to the previous Agreement said new agreement adopted for a five year period, from January 1, 2009 to January 1, 2014 and providing coverage from the same insurers;

WHEREAS at its Regular Meeting of October 18, 2010 Council awarded a mandate to René Laporte & Associés ("Laporte"), as its general consultant, along with the other members of the reconstituted municipalities from January 1, 2010 to January 1, 2011 renewable each year;

WHEREAS, in 2012 Laporte assisted the U.M.Q. to go out for public tender on behalf of the reconstituted cities and towns for a maximum period of 5 years (renewable each year, at the discretion of the City);

WHEREAS at its Regular Meeting of September 9, 2013 Council adopted a new agreement along with the reconstituted municipalities who were party to the previous Agreement said new agreement adopted for a five-year period, from January 1, 2014 to January 1, 2019 and providing coverage from the same insurers;

WHEREAS, in 2017, given the expiration of the above-mentioned five (5) year term, Fidema Groupe Conseil Inc., the City's Insurance Consultant, assisted the U.M.Q. to go out for public tender on behalf of the reconstituted cities and towns for a maximum period of 5 years (renewable each year, at the discretion of the City);

WHEREAS a tender was awarded for a five-year term starting January 1, 2018;

WHEREAS the City wishes to approve and ratify its general insurance premiums and deductibles for 2019 as the Regroupement has indeed expressed its intention to exercise its option to renew for another year;

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF MONTREAL'S APPEAL BEFORE THE SUPREME COURT OF CANADA AND REQUEST THAT THE UMQ OBTAIN INTERVENER STATUS

WHEREAS on September 6, 2018, the Supreme Court of Canada authorized the City of Montreal to appeal the judgment of *Ville de Montréal* ("Montreal") c. *Octane Stratégie inc.* (2018 QCCA 223) hereinafter referred to as "the Judgment";

WHEREAS the legal principles contained within the Judgment have a significant impact in terms of the awarding of municipal contracts; specifically pertaining to the rules of Public Order contained within the *Cities and Towns Act* (CQLR c.C-19) and the *Quebec Civil Code* (CQLR, c. CCQ-1991);

WHEREAS the principles of law debated before the Supreme Court of Canada apply not only to Montreal but to all cities and towns across Canada;

WHEREAS the legal principles which emanate from the Judgment will have a large impact on all future municipal operations (at least) province-wide as they raise significant concerns related to the municipal "indoor management rule";

WHEREAS Paragraph 10, page 57 of Montreal's factum is particularly illuminating in that it states:

"Le danger de cette nouvelle voie de contournement réside dans le fait que n'importe quel fonctionnaire pourrait, **dorénavant**, pensant 'bien faire', convenir de travaux ou de services et ainsi lier *ipso facto* une municipalité et engager son crédit pour n'importe quel montant." (Emphasis is ours)

WHEREAS there is a practical basis to not apply the *indoor management rule* to municipalities based on the following examples:

- a. A municipality must follow the rules of the <u>Cities and Towns Act</u> (CQLR c.C-19), a specific legislation, when awarding contracts;
- b. A municipality, as a general rule, speaks by resolution;
- c. Only a Delegation of Authority by-law can bind a *fonctionnaire* and only for the expenses that said *fonctionnaire* is allowed to spend;
- d. A municipality is bound by its Contract Management Policy which includes many parameters of how contracts can be awarded including details on the obligations to rotate suppliers and when bidders are declared ineligible from bidding;

WHEREAS the Legal Services Director of the City of Montreal has specifically requested that the City of Côte Saint-Luc support Montreal's appeal before the Supreme Court of Canada by adopting a resolution and asking the *Union des municipalités du Québec* ("UMQ") to intervene in the file;

WHEREAS it is in the interests of the City of Côte Saint-Luc, which is a member of the UMQ, that the Supreme Court of Canada decide on the principles of law concerning the rules governing the awarding of municipal contracts which are of Public Order which clearly state that the rules of "Indoor Management" do not apply and which cannot be violated;
