MAYOR'S OPENING STATEMENT

Prior to tonight's meeting, Mayor Brownstein provided an update on the City's situation concerning the COVID-19 pandemic and asked that a moment of silence be observed for the people who are affected by the COVID-19 virus and those who have passed away due to circumstances related to the pandemic.

QUESTION PERIOD

The question period started at 8:12 p.m. and finished at 8:25 p.m. five (5) people submitted questions prior to tonight's meeting, and they were answered during the live feed.

1) Lorna Bierbrier

The resident inquired about the recent announcement by the Quebec government that municipalities' bilingual status will potentially be challenged by virtue of the proposed Bill 96 of the Quebec government; to which Mayor Brownstein responded that the City will be taking a strong position on this matter and that a resolution will be adopted by Council at tonight's meeting in support of maintaining the City's bilingual status.

The resident also inquired about potential improvements to the median at the North End of Cavendish Boulevard where trees were recently planted, namely, the addition of benches and picnic tables; to which Mayor Brownstein responded that many benches and picnic tables were ordered by the City and that we have taken note of the resident's request. He further asked that City management ensure that a follow-up be done for the request.

The resident further inquired about the repairs of Cavendish Boulevard on the Western side of the road near the abovementioned median; to which Mayor Brownstein responded that the appropriate follow-up will be done for this request as well.

2) Norman Sabin

The resident inquired about the absence in Côte Saint-Luc of a medical center providing medical imaging for patients; to which Mayor Brownstein responded that he will follow up with the City's Public Safety Department to see what type of services are available to residents.

3) Heather Trestan Brownan

The resident inquired about the possibility of modifying the signage and regulations for curbside parking on Eldridge near the neighboring synagogues; to which Mayor Brownstein responded that a similar request was received for Heywood and Redwood, and that the City will look into the matter which will be sent to the Traffic Committee.

4) Brahm Shuster

The resident inquired about the mailing of brochures to residents concerning the implementation of the new black garbage bin program in the City and more specifically, in regard to the costs associated with the mailing of said brochures; to which Mayor Brownstein responded that the Director of Communications will send an email directly to the resident with answers to all his questions in terms of cost breakdown.

Councillor Erdelyi also provided an explanation as to why the brochures were mailed to specific addresses (and not sent as general mailing), namely, that the brochure is only intended for specific types of residential buildings excluding condominium complexes and certain townhouses.

5) Simon Arzouan

The resident inquired about the synchronization of the traffic lights on Cavendish at the Kildare, Mackle and the Avenue intersections; to which Mayor Brownstein responded that the City is well aware of the issue with the synchronization of traffic lights at those intersections as a consultant was hired to study the matter. More specifically, Mayor Brownstein explained that the synchronization is affected by the crosswalks at these intersections and that the presence of crosswalks is a matter of safety and security for pedestrians.

CDS will proceed with the transfer of funds, according to the legal requirements of the bonds and for that purpose; the Côte Saint-Luc City Council authorizes the City Treasurer to sign the documents required by the Canadian Banking system entitled “*Autorisation pour le plan de débits pré-autorisés destinée aux entreprises*”.
7. CDS will make payments of the principal and the interest to Members through electronic funds transfers and, for this purpose, CDS will directly withdraw the required amounts from the following account:

AGE AND OLDER FOR THE 2021 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS the National Assembly of Quebec passed Bill 85 on March 25, 2021 entitled *An Act to facilitate the conduct of the 7 November 2021 municipal general election in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic*;

WHEREAS the *Act to facilitate the conduct of the 7 November 2021 municipal general election in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic* authorizes the Chief Electoral Officer to modify, by regulation, a provision of the *Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities* (C.Q.L.R., chapter E-2.2.) (“Act”) including voting by mail for electors 70 years of age and older;

WHEREAS on April 30, 2021, the *Regulation amending certain municipal provisions to facilitate the conduct of the municipal general election of November 7, 2021, in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic* (“Regulation”) was published on the *Gazette officielle du Québec*;

WHEREAS the Regulation modifies the Act to include the possibility to allow, by request, voting by mail for electors 70 years of age and older where a resolution of a municipality is passed by virtue of par. 2 of section 659.4 of the Act;

WHEREAS the adoption of this resolution by the Côte Saint-Luc City Council will satisfy the requirement of the Act to allow voting by mail, by request, for Côte Saint-Luc electors 70 years of age and over;

WHEREAS it is in the interest of Côte Saint-Luc's democracy that electors have more alternatives to exercise their right to vote given the City’s high population density and high population of senior citizens;

WHEREAS allowing voting by mail is a safe way for electors to exercise their right to vote in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic and will increase voter turnout;

WHEREAS according to section 61 of the Act, at a meeting of the council of a related municipality, the Mayor informs the council of the matters that are to be considered at a future meeting of the urban agglomeration council, sets out the position the Mayor intends to take on any matter referred to at the urban agglomeration council meeting, discusses that position with the other members present and proposes the adoption of a resolution establishing the council’s stance;

WHEREAS agglomeration council meetings may be held in June 2021 for which members of the municipal council shall establish the stance that it wishes to take;

OTHER BUSINESS - RESOLUTION ON SECTION 29.1 “BILINGUAL” STATUS

WHEREAS the Charter of the French Language (“Charter”) was adopted by the Quebec National Assembly in 1977, and more than 80 municipalities throughout the Province of Quebec were recognized as having “bilingual status” pursuant to the provisions of Section 29.1 of the Charter;

WHEREAS the original provisions of the Charter allowed those municipalities that had a majority of residents who spoke a language other than French to be officially recognized under Section 29.1;

WHEREAS the City of Côte Saint-Luc has been recognized as having bilingual status under Section 29.1 of the Charter since 1977 and wishes to retain such “bilingual status”;

WHEREAS currently the Charter does not allow the recognition of “bilingual status” under Section 29.1 to be removed from a municipality or borough except at the request of such municipality or borough;

WHEREAS the Quebec National Assembly adopted Bill 170 imposing forced municipal mergers on municipalities in 2000 and simultaneously adopted companion legislation Bill 171 which drastically changed the criteria to obtain recognition under Section 29.1 of the Charter, from a majority of residents of a municipality or borough who spoke a language other than French to a majority of residents whose mother tongue was English;

WHEREAS the revised criteria under Bill 171 was imposed without consultation with municipalities recognized under Section 29.1 and adopted the narrowest and most inaccurate definition of the English-speaking communities within said municipalities or boroughs;

WHEREAS the Charter of the French Language leaves it to municipalities with bilingual status to determine if they ever wanted to abandon bilingual status and none ever has, and in 2013 when the Parti Québécois sought to revise the rules to remove this power from municipalities, the Coalition Avenir Quebec and Quebec Liberal Party made it clear that it should be up to municipalities and not the Quebec Government to determine if this status should ever be relinquished; and

WHEREAS the City of Côte Saint-Luc is concerned by recent comments from Quebec’s Minister Responsible for the French Language who stated he is considering changes to the Charter of the French Language related to bilingual status of municipalities which could put bilingual status of municipalities like Côte Saint-Luc in danger irrespective of the fact that in the 2016 census 67.1% of the population declared that English was their first official language spoken;

- THAT The City of Côte Saint-Luc will vigorously oppose any modifications to Section 29 of the Charter and demands that the Quebec National Assembly continue to recognize the acquired rights of all municipalities and boroughs that currently possess such status and refrain from adopting any legislation that allows Section 29.1 recognition of bilingual status to be removed from a

municipality or borough except at the initiative of and express request of said municipality or borough; and

- THAT The City of Côte Saint-Luc directs its clerk to send copies of this resolution to all of members of the Quebec National Assembly, to all other municipalities in Quebec officially recognized under Section 29.1 of the Charter and to the local federal member of Parliament and the Office of the Commissioner of Official Languages of Canada and the UMQ, FQM and FCM.”

4) Simon Arzouan

The resident inquired about the reopening of the arena (and more specifically, the ice hockey rentals) taking into consideration the sanitary measures; to which Mayor Brownstein responded that there is a reopening plan which respects the governmental sanitary measures and resembles the same sanitary measures as last summer.
