WHEREAS a notice of motion for the present By-law was given at the Regular Sitting of Council held on October 13, 2022.

THAT it be ordained and enacted by By-law 2537-2 entitled: "By-law 2537-2 amending By-law 2537 entitled "By-law to regulate the collection and disposal of residual materials" in order to amend the provisions regarding waste collection" as follows:

ARTICLE 1

Article 1 of By-law 2537-1 to regulate the collection and disposal of residual materials is hereby amended by:

- replacing the definition of the term "black bin" by the following:

"black bin": a black receptacle for the disposal of household waste, purchased from the City, with a capacity of 120, 240 or 360 litres or a City-approved container with a capacity of 360 liters, regardless of color, for the collection of garbage.

ARTICLE 2

Article 2 of Schedule C of this by-law is amended by replacing the following:

"The frequency of collections is established by the City. The frequency and days of the collection of residual materials are described in the following table as per the map illustrating sectors "A", "B", "C" and "D", as per Annex D."

Article 2 of Schedule C is amended by replacing Table 1 with the following:

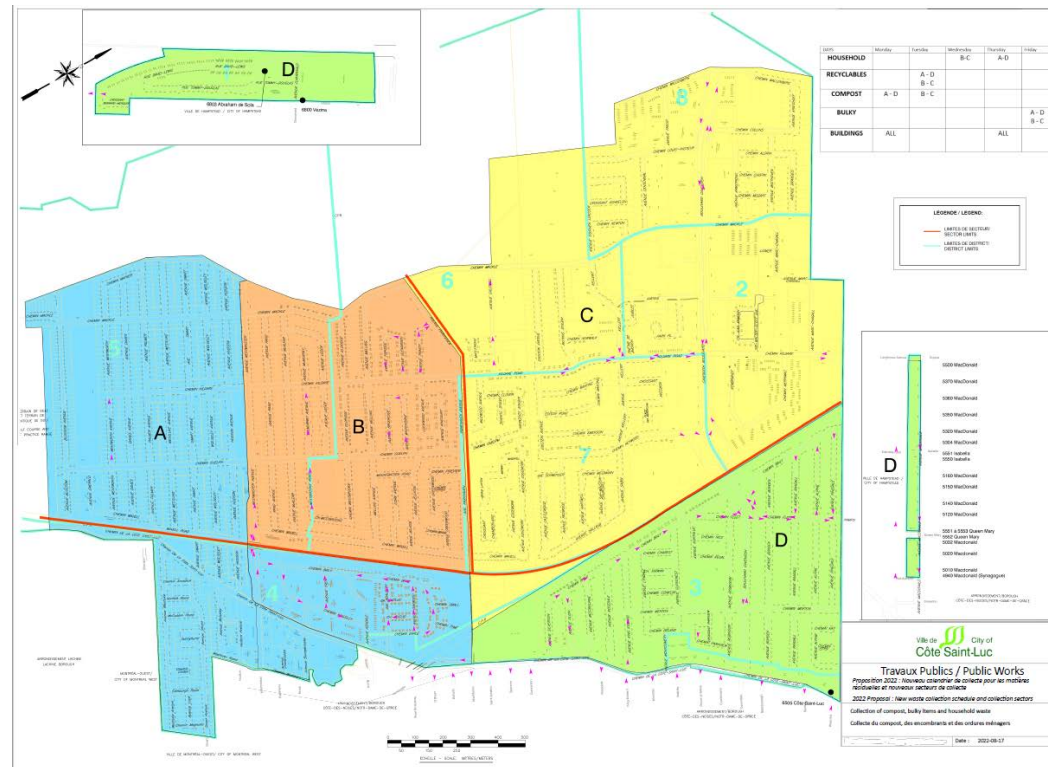
