**BY-LAW RESPECTING SPEED IN
THE STREETS**

1. In this by-law, "road vehicle" means a road vehicle as defined by the Highway Safety Code (R.S.Q., c. C-24.2).
2. No one may drive a road vehicle at a speed in excess of:
 - a) 50 km/h on Fleet Road, Cavendish Boulevard, Côte Saint-Luc Road, Kildare Avenue, Mackle Road and Guelph Road;
 - b) 30 km/h in a school zone or a park zone identified as such by signs said streets delineated in a sign plan annexed herewith as Annex A to form an integral part of the By-law;
 - c) 40 km/h in any other street of the city said streets delineated in a sign plan annexed herewith as Annex A to form an integral part of the By-law.
3. The Service de police de la Ville de Montréal is responsible for the carrying out of this by-law.
4. This by-law replaces by-laws numbers 136, 409, 625 and 1604.
5. This by-law comes into force according to law.

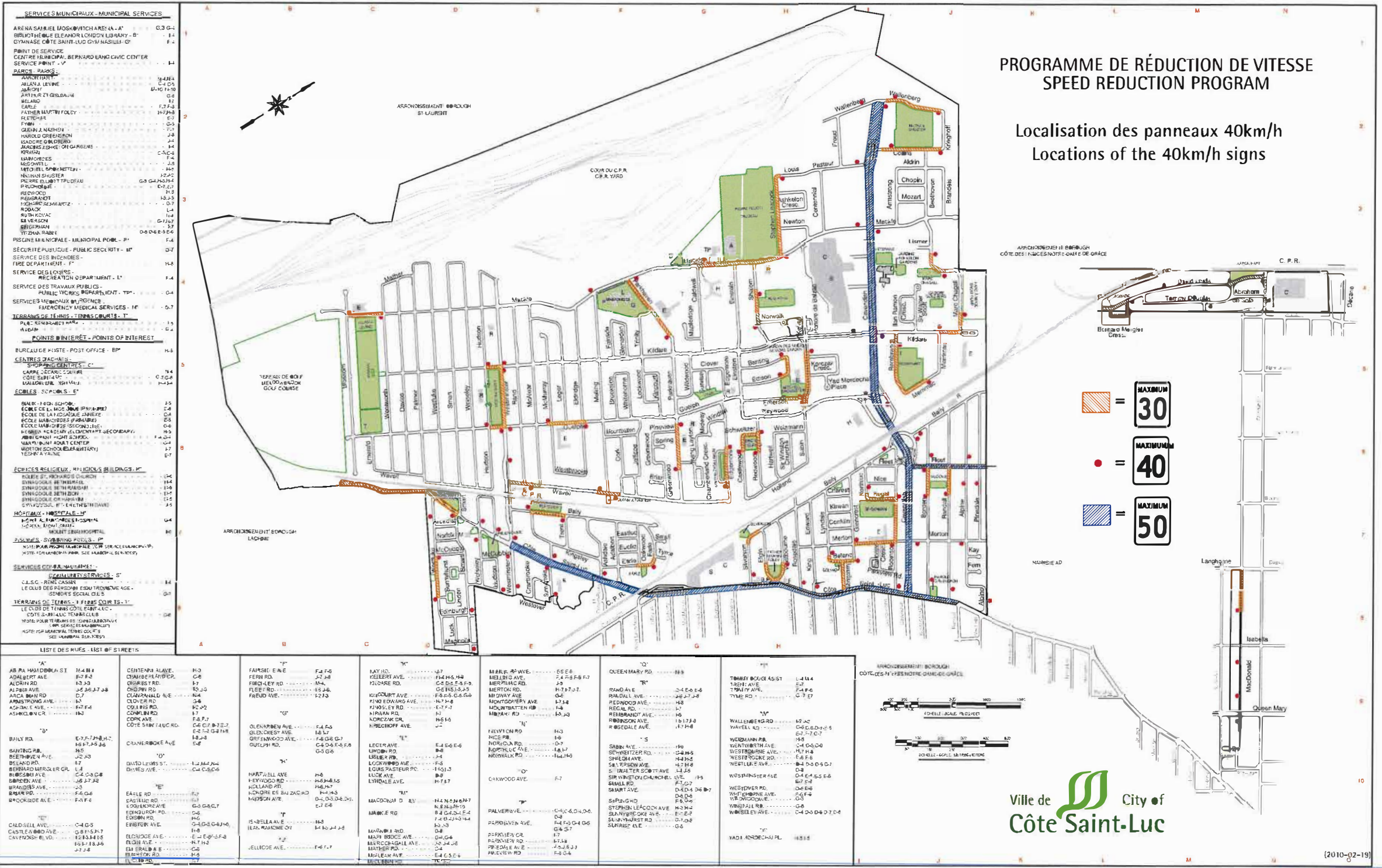
